2. **Readings** (some general reminders)

- a. For the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation, there are several options for readings found in the Lectionary (#764-#768). These readings may be used on any day **except** at Saturday Evening (if it fulfills the Sunday obligation) and Sunday Masses, the Sundays of Advent, Lent, Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, the Easter Season, and Solemnities – when the readings of the day **must** be used.
- b. During the Easter Season, the *first reading* is **always** taken from the Acts of the Apostles. The *second reading* is taken from one of the Letters of the New Testament. During the Easter Season, it is **not** appropriate to have an Old Testament reading.
- c. Outside the Easter Season, it is most appropriate to have an Old Testament *first reading*, a New Testament Letter, and a Gospel reading.
